(3) PHOTOGRAPHY: Enter your best photo GRADES 5-6-7-8

(4) NO CLASS or GROUP PROJECTS for 2018

Special Procedure for all Parishes/Schools:Pre-Registration is needed so all Participation Certificates can be ready in time for the competition. they will be mailed back to your Parishes/Schools so they don't get lost during the viewing and the competition.

E-Mail your Parish's/School's contestants with Name,Grade,Art, Craft, or Photography.

Entries will be disqualified if Name,School or Parish is on FRONT of the entry. They ALL should be in the back affixed to your entry form.

Saturday: April 7, Judging begins at 10:00 am. Only 1st Place Winners will be notified. This segment of the competition is closed to the public.

Sunday, April 8, 11:00 to 11:30 am, Contestants pick up their projects. Each parish should assign a representative to pick up entries.

## CYO ART & Craft & PHOTOGRAPHY Competition Rules

1. ART and CRAFT Categories are open to ALL Students in Grades K-8, who are eligible parishioners in any of District 5 C.Y.O. parishes. PHOTOGRAPHY IS ONLY OPEN to Students in GRADES 5-8.

2. Only entries produced by children will be eligible for competition

No evidence of parent/adult help will be accepted.

3. Teachers/Art Teachers are responsible for verification of student's work

4. Adults may instruct only

Evidence of adult work on student projects is means for disqualification.

5. Printed instructions and patterns may be used.

6. NO mosaics, traced pictures, or paint-by-number entries

will be accepted in the art division.

7. Only individual projects may be submitted

8. A Completed identification label must be attached

to the BACK of each entry.

9. Judging Categories for Children's Work.

Group A: Kindergarten

Group B: Grade 1 & 2

Group C: Grade 3 & 4

Group D: Grade 5 & 6

Group E: Grade 7 & 8

10. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place

in each group.

11. Three Judges will be selected to judge the entered projects.

12. ALL Judging is based on: Originality, Design and Execution.

consideration will be given to skill level and maturity.

13. The contest Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any/  
all entries, which do not conform to the above rules and regulations

14. PHOTOGRAPHY RULES: ENTIRE PHOTO MUST BE CLEAR; NO PEOPLE IN THE PHOTO;  
SIZE NO BIGGER THAN 8 1/2" x 11".

ORIGINALS ONLY

SIZE: 8" X 11" Minimum to 18" X 24" Maximum

Number of allowed entries per person: 1 Original

Final piece entered in the contest should show evidence of creative interpretation, artistic ability, drawing & painting skills by the creator.

# Craft Division

## Original Division

Criteria: Each project must be the student's ORIGINAL creation.

Each student creates, decides on the material to be used, and executes the project according to his/her ingenuity.

Students may consult books for guidance.

Original craft may not contain pre-cut art pieces, such as pre-cut foam shapes. The student must cut out his own shapes to make the project as original as possible.

Allowed Media:

Each Contestant may submit 1 piece of work

Wood Work: Popsicle sticks, balsa wood, carvings, wood mosaics, plaques, matchsticks.

Leatherwork: Belts, Pocketbooks and Wallets.

Metal Craft: Jewelry and Sculpture.

Needlecraft: Knitting, Crocheting, Embroidery, Cross Stitch and Quilting

Weaving: may include straw, yarn and ribbon.

Macrame: Plant Hangers, Belts, Ornaments, and Wall Hangings.

Sewing: can include any hand-made or machine-made items such as pillows, toys or quilting.

Figure Draping: items submitted may be no larger than 18" high

Ceramics: Sculptures made of bread dough, modeling clay, Plaster of Paris, or mosaics from ceramic tile.

Paper: Collages, Paper Snipping, Origami, Quilling, Mosaics, Weaving

These entries must be mounted, paper-framed (Matted, Cardboard Framed.)

Flower Arranging: no larger than 18" X 24".
